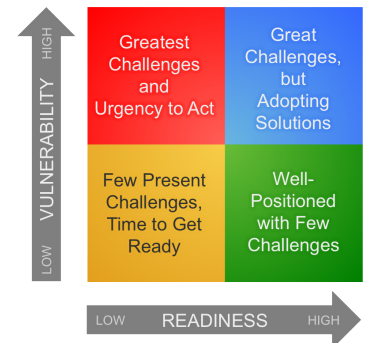
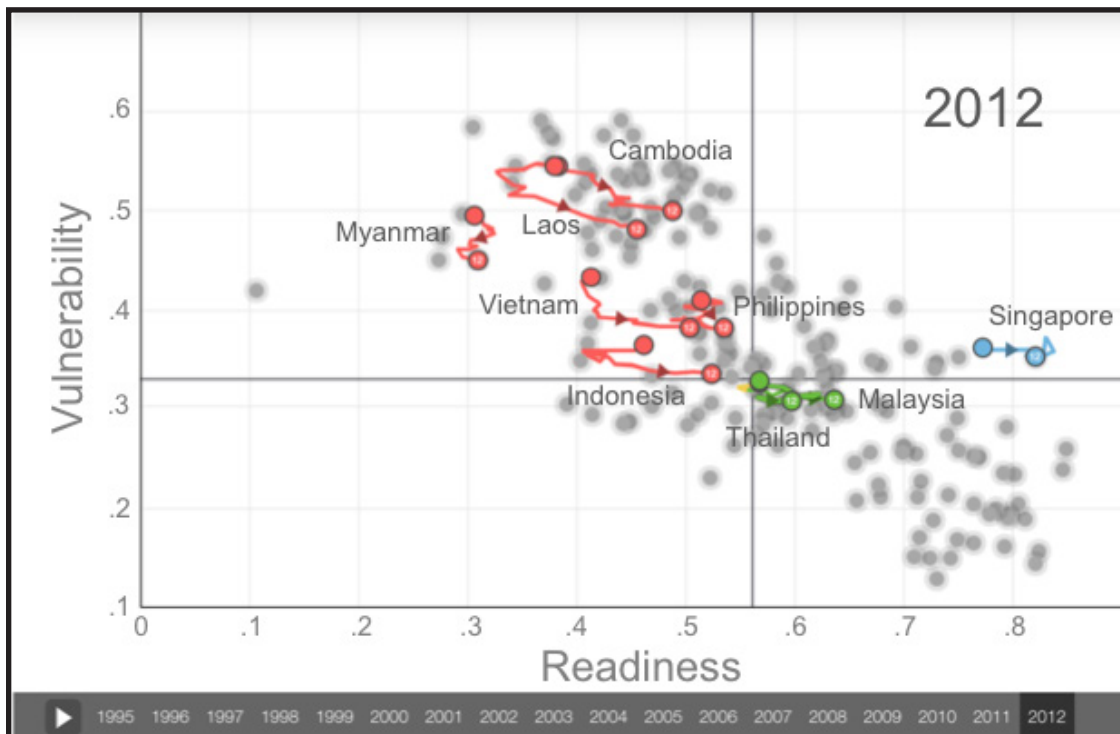

ND-Global Adaptation Index (ND-GAIN) is the developer of a formal and scientifically-based methodology that evaluates the level of a nation's preparedness to deal with global changes brought about by migration, resource-constraints and climate disruption. ND-GAIN aims to unlock global adaptation solutions in the corporate and development sector that save lives and improve livelihoods while strengthening market and policy positions.

A free and open source tool, ND-GAIN Country Index uses 17 years of data, to rank 177 countries annually based on how vulnerable they are to food insecurity, water scarcity, infrastructure failure and climate disruption and, uniquely, how ready they are to successfully implement adaptation solutions.

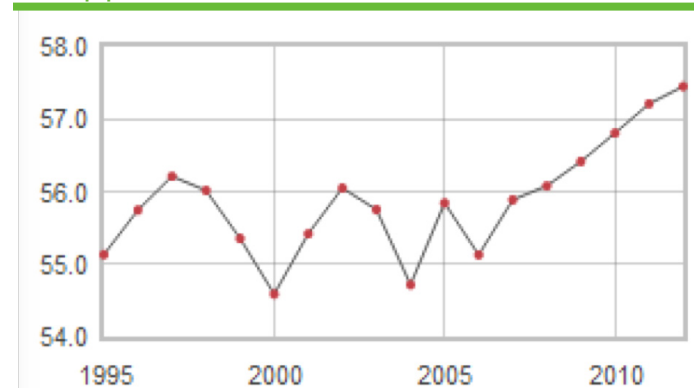
